**AN ACT Providing for Additional Washington County Taxes for the Year
Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-one**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Washington County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

Whereas, the county has no source of revenue except the taxes hereinafter mentioned; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1961 be increased and immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue for Washington County; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Washington County taxes increased. The county commissioners of Washington County are authorized to assess, collect and apply an additional county tax of \$11,858 for the year 1961 to be expended under the supervision of the Aeronautics Commission for aid in constructing a turf landing field at Machias. State and other funds have already been appropriated to finance a part of the project. The additional county tax for the County of Washington for the year 1961 may be apportioned during the month of April of said year upon the last state valuation.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
