HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1117, L.D. 1539, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Definition of Public School Under Maine  
State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

' "Public school" shall mean any public school conducted  
within the State under the authority and supervision of a duly  
elected board of education, superintending school committee  
or school directors and any school which received any direct  
state aid in 1950, and municipal tuition funds amounting to  
at least the amount of such state aid, during the same year.  
For purposes of the retirement system, Good Will Home  
Association and Oak Grove School shall be considered as public  
schools.'
