STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Public School Under Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes which defines "public school", as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, and as amended by chapter 348 and section 36 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

"Public school" shall mean any public school conducted within the State under the authority and supervision of a duly elected board of education or superintending school committee or school directors and any school which received any direct state aid in 1950, and municipal tuition funds amounting to at least the amount of such state aid during the same year. For purposes of the retirement system Good Will Home Association shall be considered a public school."
