## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

## AN ACT Permitting Governor of Penobscot Tribe of Indians to Bring Action for Money Due.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 25, § 329, amended.** Section 329 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 329. Governor of Penobscot Tribe may sue in name of tribe. The <del>commissioner</del> Governor of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians, with the consent of the Penobscot Tribe Council, may, in his own name the name of the tribe and in his said capacity, maintain actions for money due to any Indians, and for injuries done to them or their property; and all. All sums or damages so recovered shall be distributed to the Indians of the tribe, according to their usages, or be invested in useful articles. This section shall apply only to public and unassigned lands not privately owned.'
