## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Taking of Alewives in Waters Leading to Winnegance Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1959, c. 155, § 78, amended. The first sentence of section 78 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959 is amended to read as follows:

'Exclusive rights to the taking of alewives from Winnegance Lake in the City of Bath and the Towns of Phippsburg and West Bath and all waters leading to Winnegance Lake shall be optional with the city and towns.'
