SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1131, L. D. 1558, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Unprotected Wells."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of "Sec. 32-B." and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 32-B. Definition. The term "well" as used in this
section and section 32-C shall mean a deep, narrow pit in the earth,
usually walled, used for the purpose of obtaining a supply of water.'

Further amend said Bill, in "Sec. 32-C.", by striking out in
the 6th and 7th lines the underlined words "Violation of this section
shall create an attractive nuisance and whoever" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined word 'Whoever'
