SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1132, L. D. 1559, Bill, "An Act Relative to the Granting of Licenses for Certain Businesses and Purposes by the Municipal Officers of the Town of Old Orchard Beach."

Amend said Bill in the title by adding at the end before the period the words 'and the Town of Bar Harbor'

Further amend said Bill by adding after the words "Old Orchard Beach" in the 3rd and 8th lines the words 'and the Town of Bar Harbor'

Further amend said Bill in the 2nd line of section 1 by adding after the words "Old Orchard Beach" the words 'and the Town of Bar Harbor'; and by adding after the word "licenses" in the 3rd line the words 'in their respective towns'

Further amend said Bill in the 5th line of section 1 by adding after the word and comma "ordinance," the words and punctuation 'and as the municipal officers of the Town of Bar Harbor may make, vote and establish by ordinance,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 a new sentence to read as follows:

'A business engaging in any of the categories listed in section 3 may be listed for that category even though engaging in other categories not included in section 3.'

Further amend said Bill in the 2nd line of section 2 by adding after the words "Old Orchard Beach" the words 'and the Town of Bar Harbor'

Further amend said Bill in the first line of section 4 by striking out the words "municipal officers of the"; and in the 5th line of section 4 by striking out the words "municipal officers" and inserting in place thereof the word 'town'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 a new section to read as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. Violation and penalties. The municipal officers of the Town of Bar Harbor may provide a penalty of not more than \$100 for the violation of any ordinance authorized by this act. All fines shall be recovered on complaint for the use of the municipality. The municipal officers may further provide by ordinance that any license issued under any ordinance may be suspended or revoked, and in the event of an appeal from conviction said license may be suspended until such time as a final decision has been rendered by the court.'
