RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Establishment of a School of Practical Nursing in Portland or Vicinity.

Establishment of a School of Practical Nursing; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, to the Department of Education, the sum of \$76,009 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$47,883 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963. Said sums shall be used for the purpose of establishing and operating a State School of Practical Nursing in Portland or the vicinity.

The above amounts shall be transferred to the General Fund for expenditure and the breakdown shall be as follows:
