RESOLVE, in Favor of Walter Lanoue of Limerick.

Walter Lanoue; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$350 to be paid to Walter Lanoue of Limerick for damage to his house by the State Police in pursuing an alleged criminal.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Lanoue's house was damaged in May 1959 while State Police were pursuing an alleged criminal. The house was occupied by the State Police as a cover and many windows were broken and other damage created by flying bullets.
