IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Annual Compensation for Superior Court Messenger of
Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 149-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 149-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 149-A. Superior court messenger of Cumberland County. The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall receive an annual salary of \$4,250 in full compensation for service and attendance.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XV, amended. The last sentence of subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 267 of the public laws of 1955 and amended by section 3 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed as follows:

~~'The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall also receive \$11 per day for court vacation time, service and attendance when said service and attendance are authorized by a Justice of the Superior Court.'~~
