STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to County Appropriations for Industrial Development.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 16-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 16-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 16-A. Industrial development. At the request of the county commissioners of any county the State Department of Economic Devolopment may assign personnel to such county to aid in planning its industrial growth and development. The expenses and salary of such personnel shall be paid for by county funds but shall not exceed \$12,500 annually.'
