SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 547, L. D. 1591, Bill, "An Act to Clarify State Boating Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting immediately following the enacting clause the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 36-A, §2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 36-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 349 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

"Waters of this State" means any inland body of water, wholly or partly within the territorial limits of the State, and all rivers and streams above tidewater, except that for the purpose of issuing a certificate of number as hereinafter provided "waters of this State" shall mean any body of water, wholly or partly within the territorial limits of this State."

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 10 to be 2 to 11.
