HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1157, L. D. 1594, Bill,
"An Act Creating a District Court to Integrate Activities of
Municipal Courts and Trial Justices."

and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '14'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 9."
of section 1 by striking out the period at the end of the 2nd
sentence and inserting in place thereof the underlined punctuation
and words ',except that in District 9 there shall be 2 judges
appointed who shall be residents thereof.'
