CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1165, L. D. 1606, Bill, "An Act Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1962 and June 30, 1963."

Amend said Bill under the caption "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out the line:

"All Other 216,890 218,170" and inserting in place thereof the line:

'All Other 191,890 193,170'

Further amend said Bill under the caption "ECONOMIC DEVELOP-MENT, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

'Also provides travel of \$27,500, industrial advertising of \$70,000, recreational advertising of \$235,560, and related office expenses and equipment.'

Further amend said Bill under the caption "EMPLOYEES SALARY ADJUSTMENT PLAN" by striking out the line:

"Personal Services 580,000 580,000"

and inserting in place thereof the line:

'Personal Services 370,000 370,000'

Further amend said Bill under the caption "HEALTH AND WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out the following lines:

"Medical Care Program

All Other 1,000,000 1,000,000^{tt}

and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Medical Care Program

All Other 677,000 675,000

Welfare Administration

Personal Services (15) 55,107 (15) 57,684
All Other 14,893 15,316
Capital Expenditures 3,000 2,000
73,000 75,000
