HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1165, L.D. 1606, Bill, "An Act Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1962 and June 30, 1963."

Amend said Bill under the caption "MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" by inserting after the paragraph entitled "Boys Training Center" the following:

'Pineland Hospital and Training Center

Personal Services	-----	(44) 83,052
All Other	-----	12,625
Capital Expenditures	-----	66,600'

Provides 44 new positions, necessary capital equipment and related operating expenses necessary to operate this new unit for 9 months with an estimated patient population of 120.

(It is the intent of the Legislature that these moneys shall become available only, when and if negotiations with the Federal Government for title to this property are successful.)  
(Land and buildings located in Perham, Maine.)

Further amend said Bill by correcting the totals therein affected by the adoption of this amendment.
