HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to H. P. 1165, L. D. 1606, Bill, "An Act Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1962 and June 30, 1963."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the following:

Provides two Industrial Development field representatives, two Recreational Development representatives, a clerk-stenographer and seasonal help-\$58,840. Also provides travel of \$27,500, recreational advertising of \$120,000, promotional advertising of \$235,560, and related office expenses and equipment"

Further amend said Bill by correcting the totals therein affected by the adoption of this amendment.
