STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Aides-de-Camp Appointed by Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 9, amended. The first sentence of section 9 of chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The staff of the Commander in Chief shall consist of the Adjutant General, who shall be ex officio chief of staff, quartermaster general and paymaster general with rank of brigadier major general; the senior officer on duty with each of the staff departments; and such aides-de-camp not to exceed 9 10 in number, one of whom may be a naval aide with rank of captain and one of whom may be an air force aide, as may be appointed by the Governor.'
