HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1169, L. D. 1614, Bill, "An Act Revising the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 10." of section 1 by adding at the end the following underlined subsection:

'V. Mobile registration. Nothing in this section shall prevent a member of a board of registration from taking the registration application of any person, nor, at the discretion of the board, from presenting himself at any voting place or mobile registration unit for the purpose of taking applications for registration when the board is in open session. Action upon all applications so obtained shall be taken by the board only.
