HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1172, L. D. 1617, Bill, "An Act Relating to Special Deputies for Kennebec County."

Amend said Bill, in the title, by striking out the word "Kennebec" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Knox'

Further amend said Bill, in the 4th line, by striking out the underlined word "Kennebec" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'Knox'; and by striking out, in the 5th line, the underlined word "Kennebec" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'Knox'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined sentence: 'Such full-time deputy sheriffs for Knox County shall not receive more than \$77 in the aggregate for any one week.'
