HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1175, L. D. 1621, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Harness Racing Purses."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause, the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is necessary for the harness
horse race meets which may be conducted in the State of Maine during
the spring and summer of 1961; and

Whereas, the following legislation will produce better harness
race meets in Maine for the benefit of the people of Maine and
summer visitors; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
