COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 600, L. D. 1640, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Educational Foundation Program Allowance."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by adding after the word "Allowance" the words 'and Teachers' Salaries'

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the first line the words "This act" and inserting in place thereof the word and figure 'Section 1'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following section:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 41, § 237-A, amended. The first paragraph of section 237-A of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 364 and repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 433, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Each administrative unit operating public schools within the State shall employ only certified teachers and after July 1, ~~1958~~ 1963 shall pay such teachers, except substitute teachers as defined by the State commissioner of Education, the minimum salaries as follows:
