IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide Aid to Maine Industries to Obtain Government Contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Government contract procurement. The Commissioner of Economic Development is authorized to employ a contract procurement officer to encourage and assist the industries of the State in procuring contracts for their products with local, State and Federal Governments by providing necessary information and assistance to advance such contractual relation.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$9,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$19,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to be expended in carrying out the purposes of this act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
