STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide Funds for the Support of Cardiac and Related Services.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas the State of Maine, through the Department of Health and Welfare, supported cardiac and related services; and

Whereas, such services, although vital to the health and welfare of the people of Maine, will have to be curtailed or eliminated because of lack of funds; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to continue such services; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency with the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for cardiac and related services. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 for the support of cardiac and related services. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall become effective January 1, 1962.
