RESOLVE, in Favor of Ross Sinclair of New Gloucester.

Ross Sinclair; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$4,000 to be paid to Ross Sinclair, of New Gloucester, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to his house by fire set by certain patients at Pineland Hospital and Training Center.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On April 9, 1961, certain inmates of Pineland Hospital and Training Center set fire to Mr. Sinclair's house and damage was to the amount of \$4,000.
