Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety ; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**School Administrative District for Deer Isle and Stonington authorized.** The municipalities of Deer Isle and Stonington are exempted from the limitations provided in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 41, section III-E, as amended, and the Maine School District Commission is authorized to proceed pursuant to sections III-F to III-U-1 of said chapter 41 to take the necessary action to allow the municipalities of Deer Isle and Stonington to form a School Administrative District.

Nothing contained in this act shall be construed to limit the number of times that the within-named municipalities may make application to the Maine School District Commission, nor shall the authority heretofore granted to the Maine School District Commission under this act be limited to any specified number of times for the commission to authorize the within-named municipalities to act on the formation of a school administrative district.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
