SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1207, L. D. 1660, Bill, "An Act to
Divide the Town of Enfield, Penobscot County, Into Two
Communities."

Amend said Bill in section 10 by striking out the 2nd para-
graph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'The town clerk shall prepare the required ballots on which
he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following
question: "Shall the Act to Incorporate the Town of Enfield, as
passed by the First Special Session of the 100th Legislature, be
accepted?" The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed
against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act
shall take effect for all purposes hereof immediately upon its accept-
ance by 80% of the legal voters/^{voting} at said special election.'
