**AN ACT Creating a State Committee on Transportation Needs in Casco Bay.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. State Committee on Transportation Needs in Casco Bay.** The Governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent of the Council, 7 persons to include members of the Legislature and representatives of the public generally, who shall constitute the State Committee on Transportation Needs in Casco Bay. The members of the committee shall serve during the pleasure of the Governor and shall be reimbursed for their expenses actually and necessarily incurred by them in the performance of their duties.

**Sec. 2. Duties of the committee.** The committee shall study the present adequacy of public transportation in Casco Bay, and the extent to which improvements must be provided to meet the region's present and future transportation needs.

**Sec. 3. Report.** The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the 101st Legislature.

**Sec. 4. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Said appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1963.
