RESOLVE, Dividing the State of Maine into Councillor Districts.

Apportionment Executive Councillor Districts. Resolved: That for the years 1963 to and including the year 1972, the State is divided into 7 councillor districts, each of which districts shall be entitled to one councillor to be chosen in the manner prescribed by the Constitution and laws of the State, as follows:

First District: York, 1963-1964; 1965-1966; 1971-1972.
Oxford, 1967-1968; 1969-1970.

Second District: Cumberland, one for each year.

Third District: Sagadahoc, 1963-1964. Androscoggin, 1965-1966; 1969-1970;
1971-1972. Franklin, 1967-1968.

Fourth District: Somerset, 1963-1964; 1965-1966. Kennebec, 1967-1968;
1969-1970; 1971-1972.

Fifth District: Lincoln, 1963-1964. Waldo, 1965-1966. Hancock, 1967-1968;
1969-1970. Knox, 1971-1972.

Sixth District: Piscataquis, 1963-1964. Penobscot, 1965-1966; 1967-1968;
1969-1970; 1971-1972.

Seventh District: Washington, 1963-1964; 1965-1966. Aroostook, 1967-1968;
1969-1970; 1971-1972.
