STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Ernest Herrick of New Gloucester for Damage to House and Interior.

Ernest Herrick; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$871 to be paid to Ernest Herrick of New Gloucester, to reimburse him for damage to his house and interior and furniture during the spring of 1961 by certain inmates of Pineland Hospital and Training Center.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Herrick is 81 years of age and carried no insurance for the damage done to his property. This resolve by reimbursing Mr. Herrick will alleviate a great hardship and inconvenience.
