CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to JOINT HOUSE
ORDER (H. P. 1081) Relating to Search and Seizure.

Amend said Joint House Order by striking out all
of the first paragraph.

Further amend said Joint House Order by striking
out everything after the word and punctuation "concurring,"
in the first line of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in
place thereof the following: 'that there be created an
Interim Joint Commission to consist of 2 Senators, to be
appointed by the President of the Senate, 3 Representatives,
to be appointed by the Speaker of the House, 3 members,
to be appointed by the Governor, and the Attorney General,
or the Deputy or an Assistant Attorney General designated
by him to serve during his pleasure and in his stead, to
study and report to the 102nd Legislature on whether the
present statutory provisions of the State governing the
procedure on search and seizure comply with recent decisions
of the United States Supreme Court upon said subject matter.'
