STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Vocational High Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 41, § 103-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 103-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 103-A. Free vocational high schools. A single administrative unit, where the April 1st enrollment of resident and tuition pupils in grades 9 through 12 is 300 or more, shall establish and maintain a free vocational high school. Such high school shall be made available to adults residing in the administrative unit for night classes in vocational training.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. An administrative unit shall complete the construction of such vocational high school on or before September 1, 1969.
