SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 6, L. D. 6, Bill, "An Act Relating  
to Sunday Sales of Liquor By Hotels and Class A Restaurants."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the following:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 61, §2, sub-§II-B, additional. Section 2  
of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further  
amended by adding a new subsection II-B, to read as follows:

'II-B. Shall Sunday sales of liquor by hotels and class A  
restaurants be permitted in this city or town?'

Sec. 4. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that  
sections 1 and 2 of this act shall apply in those municipalities  
which voted in the affirmative to permit the sale of spirits and  
malt liquor to be consumed on the premises of hotels and class A  
restaurants for the calendar years 1963 and 1964, and that the  
local option question provided in section 3 of this act shall be  
voted upon by the respective municipalities at the biennial  
election in 1964 for the calendar years 1965 and 1966, and shall  
be so voted upon biennially thereafter."
