RESOLVE, Increasing Retirement Benefit for Georgia Dinsmore of Bath.

Georgia Dinsmore; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That Georgia Dinsmore of Bath receive an increase in the amount of retirement benefit which she is presently receiving under the Maine State Retirement Law so that her retirement benefit will be \$35 per month, to be paid from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Dinsmore retired in October, 1944, after 25 years of service and is presently receiving a retirement benefit of \$27.70 per month. This resolve is to increase the benefit to \$35 per month.
