RESOLVE, Regulating Salmon Fishing in Tunk Lake, Hancock County and Nahmakanta Lake, Piscataquis County.

Salmon fishing regulated; Tunk Lake, Hancock County; Nahmakanta Lake, Piscataquis County. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing the size limit on salmon in Tunk Lake, Hancock County, and Nahmakanta Lake, Piscataquis County, from 14 inches in length to 12 inches in length.
