SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 32, L. D. 26, Resolve, "Providing Industrial Accident Payments to Mrs. Jeanne T. Smith of Thomaston."

Amend said Resolve by inserting immediately following the title the following emergency preamble:

'Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, to prevent undue hardship the industrial accident payments under this resolve should begin July 1, 1963 since payments authorized by the Governor and Council will cease June 30, 1963; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore be it,'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end before the statement of facts the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall become effective July 1, 1963.'
