STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Catch of Fish in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 45, amended. The first sentence of section 45 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than 10 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the ~~rivers, streams, brooks, lakes and ponds~~ inland waters of the State **except in the County of Aroostook and** except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 9.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 45, amended. Section 45 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by inserting after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than 15 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of Aroostook County except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 9.'
