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## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 101st LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 39, L. D. 32, Bill, "An Act Relating to Inspection of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 13-A." of section 1 by inserting at the end a new underlined paragraph to read as follows:

'Any vehicle required by law to be registered in this and any other state may be exempt from the first paragraph of this section, providing said vehicle bears a valid inspection sticker issued by such other state.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 13-C." of section 1 by striking out all of the 3rd underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Chief of the State Police before issuing said license may require the applicant to file proof of financial responsibility or to post a bond conditioned so as to compensate for any damage to a vehicle during an inspection or adjustment due to negligence on the part of such applicant or his employees, provided, that the aggregate liability of the surety for all such damages shall, in no event, exceed the amount of such bond or proof of responsibility. Said bond or proof of responsibility shall, in no case, amount to less than \$5,000.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 13-E." of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 13-E. Disposition of fees. The amount received from the fees under sections 13-A to 13-D shall be credited to the General Highway Fund.'
