STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Town Highway Equipment on Private Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 96, § 32, repealed and replaced. Section 32 of chapter 96 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 32. Highway equipment on private roads. The inhabitants of any town or village corporation at a legal town or village corporation meeting may authorize the selectmen of the town or assessors of a village corporation to use its highway equipment, or otherwise provide equipment, to maintain or build, to remove snow from or to sand, when necessary, private roads within such town or village corporation, provided that there are 10 or more families living on these roads on a permanent all year round basis.'
