# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

### AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and amended by section 1 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1961, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Penobscot County, is further amended to read as follows:

'county attorney, \$5,000 \$6,500; first assistant county attorney, \$4,000 \$5,000'

Sec. 2. **Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Personal Services category of the Attorney General the sum of \$2,080 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
