**AN ACT Providing for Driver Education for All New Applicants for Operators' Licenses.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 60-A, amended.** The first sentence of section 60-A of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 221 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'~~After the first day of September, 1960, No~~ operator's license shall be issued to any person ~~under 17 years of age~~ **who applies for an operator's license for the first time** unless such person shall present a certificate of successful completion of a driver education course and examination given by the public secondary schools and academies receiving tuition students as described in chapter 41, section 107; or certificate of successful completion of a driver education course and examination given by some person or persons licensed by the Secretary of State.'
