AN ACT Providing Special License Plates for United States Postmasters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 34-B, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 34-B, as follows:

‘Sec. 34-B. Special plates for postmasters. Owners of motor vehicles who are residents of this State and who are United States postmasters, upon application, complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration of motor vehicles and complying with section 34-A, shall be issued license plates for private passenger cars of a color, shape and content to be selected by the Secretary of State.’
