IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, In Favor of Fred Salem of Millinocket.

Fred Salem; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$400 to Fred Salem of Millinocket, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, to reimburse him for expenses paid by him in defending certain actions brought against his son, John Salem, which actions were nol prossed on appeals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

John Salem was tried in Millinocket Municipal Court in October, 1961 for reckless driving. Found guilty. This case appealed to January term of Penobscot County Superior Court. Nol prossed. John Salem was again tried in Millinocket Municipal Court on January 26, 1962 for leaving the scene of an accident. Found guilty and case appealed to the April term of Penobscot County Superior Court. Nol prossed.

The cost of defending these cases is as follows:

Attorney fees, \$275; mileage, \$70; meals and telephone, \$55, total of \$400.
