RESOLVE, in Favor of Earle M. Hinkley of Gardiner.

Earle M. Hinkley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$700 to be paid to Earle M. Hinkley of Gardiner, as full and final settlement of his claim against the State for losses sustained on June 14, 1961 when an automobile which he was driving collided with a State Highway Department truck and sweeper on Route No. 102 leading from Southwest Harbor to Ellsworth.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On June 14, 1961 Mr. Hinkley was on Route 102 driving from Southwest Harbor on state business for the Liquor Commission. While traveling well within the speed limit he met a car going in the opposite direction which stirred up dust from a sweeper that was operating beyond a curve just ahead of him. He applied his brakes but could not stop in time to avoid hitting the sweeper. His car was considered a total wreck and he would like to recover \$700 for the loss of his car.
