HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 25, L. D. 49, Bill, "An Act
Repealing Supplemental State Aid for Reorganized
School Districts."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause
the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 41, §237-E, amended. The 6th
paragraph from the end of section 237-E of chapter 41 of the
Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 18 of chapter 353
of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'The subsidy for a newly formed school administrative
district shall be the sum of the amounts that the towns would
have received ~~plus-a-10%-bonus~~. During the next succeeding
biennium a School Administrative District, regardless of the
previous net operating costs of the subordinate administrative
units, shall receive its subsidy based on the average net
foundation program of the district ~~plus-the-additional-bonus
as-provided-in-section-237-6.~~'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning
of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the
following new section:

'Sec. 3. Application. School administrative districts
entitled to the bonus during the year 1963 under the Revised
Statutes, chapter 41, sections 237-E and 237-G, but for the
provisions of this act, shall receive the 10% bonus in 1963
and 1964. They shall receive a 5% bonus in 1965 and 1966.'
