COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 29, L.D. 53, Bill,
"An Act Permitting Separate Ballot Boxes
for Votes on Constitutional Amendments and
Referendums."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined sentences:

'If such separate ballot boxes are to be used, they shall be subject to all the provisions relating to official ballot boxes, as provided in this section. They shall be furnished by the Secretary of State at the expense of the municipality.'
