COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 30, L.D. 54, Bill, "An Act
Increasing Fees and Clarifying Barber Licensing Law."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 1" in paragraph "C" by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "tinting," and before the word "shampooing" the underlined word and punctuation "bleaching," and by inserting after the semicolon and before the single quotation mark at the end, the following underlined words and punctuation, 'and such dyeing, tinting or bleaching shall not be practiced unless the barber or apprentice barber has taken a course with a minimum of 75 hours in such practices, approved by the board; '
