STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Transportation of Deer by Maine Members of Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 99, amended. The first paragraph of section 99 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No person shall sell or give away any deer or part thereof to be transported or carried beyond the limits of this State nor shall any person buy or accept as a gift any deer or part thereof for its transportation; nor shall any resident of this State at any time carry or transport in any manner or attempt to carry or transport in any manner beyond the limits of this State any deer or part thereof; provided, however, that any. Any resident of this State may purchase a license which will entitle him to transport or cause to be transported a deer legally killed by him within this State to a place beyond the limits of this State, and the fee for this license shall be \$20.50; except that no fee shall be required of any resident of this State who is serving in the armed forces of the United States.'
