IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Free Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Persons Over Sixty-Five Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ XII-D, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection XII-D, to read as follows:

'XII-D. Licenses for persons over 65 years of age. A license to hunt or fish shall be issued without any charge or fee to any resident of Maine who is over 65 years of age.'
