RESOLVE, Relating to Black Bass Fishing in Certain Kennebec County Waters.

Fishing in certain Kennebec County waters. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Maranacook Lake, Annabessacook Lake, Wilson Pond, Cobbossee Lake and Narrows Pond, Kennebec County, on May 28th to the taking of 3 black bass per day on single-pointed hooked artificial lures only.
