AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Operation of Motor Vehicles by Unlicensed Persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 65, amended. Section 65 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 181 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Any person, not previously licensed to operate a motor vehicle in this or any other State, who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 which fine shall not be suspended; and in addition shall not be licensed or permitted to operate a motor vehicle for 60 days.'
